in accordance with REACH

The regulation **(EC) No 1907/2006 (REACH)** of the European Parliament and Council of 18 December 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) entered into force on 1st of June 2007. It regulates the handling of chemical substances in preparations and products.

REACH shall ensure that the use of chemical substances can be traced from production to final application. **Wolfram Bergbau und Hütten AG** actively supports the regulation's main goal to protect the human health and environment.

Registration of our substances in accordance with the REACH Regulation

Wolfram Bergbau und Hütten AG is a "manufacturer" within the meaning of REACH. Our products are considered as "substances" and as such they are subject to registration.

The following product groups have been registered:

- Tungsten Oxide
- Tungsten Trioxide
- Tungsten powder
- Tungsten carbide powder

Information on substances of very high concern (SVHC) under Article 33 of the REACH Regulation

Wolfram Bergbau und Hütten AG is under Article 33 (1) of the REACH Regulation obliged to inform customers if the supplied products contain substances of the "SVHC Candidate List" in a concentration greater than 0,1% weight by weight (w/w).

The SVHC candidate list is regularly updated by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) and published on <https://echa.europa.eu/de/candidate-list-table>

Wolfram Bergbau und Hütten AG confirms for our products - according to the current state of knowledge - that they do not contain substances from the list of substances of very high concern (SVHC candidate list) in accordance with Article 59 of the EU Chemicals Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 (REACH Regulation) with more than 0,1 % weight by weight (w/w).

Wolfram Bergbau und Hütten AG also confirms that all the above-mentioned products are compliant with the REACH Regulation.

Additional Information

- **PBT or vPvB:** Our products are inorganic substances and therefore, the PBT and vPvB assessment is not required.
- **Endocrine disrupting properties:** The products do not have endocrine disrupting properties according to Regulation (EU) 2017/2100.
- **POP Regulation:** The POP Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 does not apply to inorganic substances.
